O. B. McClintock Company Vault Ventilator - (Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA) Patented various dates 1921-26. A vault ventilator is inserted in a steel-lined horizontal hole of the vault wall, usually placed chest high, in order that if someone is locked inside the vault, they can remove the heavy plug, insert a fan (see other entries), and receive fresh air until they can be rescued. The steel pin, shown, is inserted through the plug and it's steel housing, and locks the plug in place from the inside. This particular model is the smallest plug of the three shown.
