

## Cary Safe

**Kolekcja:** American 19th-20th Century Safes

**Opis:** Cary Safe Company, Buffalo, New York, Patent Jan. 21, 1890, Door rotates to screw open/shut. Has combination dial with key lock, two movement timelock. Circular door to cover internal workings removed (broken hinges). To close and secure: First, set both time clocks for at least 1 hour. Second, cock the spring loaded mechanism (see key in picture 4). Third, crank the door shut. As the door reaches maximum closure, a cam is activated which releases and extends the locking bolt. When time has elapsed (when either time clock reaches zero minutes) the bolt is retracted, and, provided the combination has been dialed, you may crank the door open. Circular opening is 13 1/2" outside and 11 1/4" inside. Steel walls 3" thick. Bronze crane hinge is 7/8" thick. Overall dimensions: 2' wide, depth and height both 1' 10".
